- AB 237 (Irwin) – BPPE / CSAAVE
- AB 1340 (Chiu) – California GE
- AB 1341 (Berman) – “Covert” For Profit
- AB 1342 (Low) – AG approval of Non-Profit conversion
- AB 1343 (Eggman) – California 85/15
- AB 1344 (Bauer-Kahan) – Out of State Online Schools
- AB 1345 (McCarty) – Employee Compensation
- AB 1346 (Medina) – STRF
