# 2025-26 Legislative Session

- 30+ New Legislators
  - Will stabilize in 2026
  - Committee Chairs / Leadership
- Republicans Picked up 3 Seats
  - 2 Assembly, 1 Senate
  - Democrats still maintain 2/3 majority
- Trump 2.0 Response
  - Special Session
- Legislative Hearings Picking Up
- Governor Newsom “lame duck”



# Statewide Issues (No shortage)

- LA Fires (countless bills)
- Insurance
- Affordability (more talk than action)
  - Housing / Energy / Food / Etc.
- Homelessness / Crime
- State Budget
  - Deficit looming
  - Unknown Federal Dollars
